KPGB bags RM404m KL residential project deal

KERJAYA Prospek Group Bhd (KPGB) has secured a significant RM404.4 million contract from Ecofirst Consolidated Bhd for a residential development project in Kuala Lumpur (KL). The project involves the construction of two apartment blocks, including a 39-storey service apartment, basement, podium, eight-storey car park and commercial unit. Construction is scheduled to begin on Aug 1, 2023, and is expected to last for 36 months. The contract brings Kerjaya Prospek's year-to-date wins to RM937.8 million, accounting for 78.2% of its annual target. The company's outstanding orderbook now stands at RM4.7 billion, which further strengthens its financial outlook for the future. — TMR
