

Kerjaya Prospek subsidiaries win RM198m in new contracts

KERJAYA Prospek Group Bhd's subsidiaries, Permatang Bakti Sdn Bhd and Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd (KPM), have secured two construction contracts totalling RM197.7 million.

Permatang Bakti will build the 39-storey Viera 15 serviced apartment in Shah Alam, comprising 479 units and six levels of podium parking, in a RM100.2 million contract.

KPM will construct five 80-metre canal bridges at Andaman Island, Penang, under a RM97.5 million contract starting Nov 24, with completion targeted in 33 months.

Kerjaya Prospek CEO Tee Eng Tiong said the projects will strengthen the group's presence in key urbanisation hubs.

With these wins, the group has secured nine contracts worth RM1.16 billion so far this year, bringing its outstanding order book to RM3.7 billion. — **TMR**
