

Kerjaya Prospek secures RM98.8 mln hospital project in Seremban 2

KUALA Construction firm Kerjaya Prospek Group Berhad has secured a RM98.8 million contract to build a private hospital in Seremban 2, Negeri Sembilan.

The contract was awarded to its wholly owned subsidiary, Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd, by Sena Letrik (M) Sdn Bhd, marking the group's first project with the client.

The scope of works includes

LUMPUR: the construction of an eight-storey hospital complex, covering main building works as well as mechanical and electrical installations.

The project is set to commence immediately and is scheduled for completion within 18 months.

construction beyond its core residential segment.
