

Kerjaya Prospek Wins RM52 Million Data Centre Civil Work Subcontract In Klang Valley

Kerjaya Prospek Group Berhad has secured a RM52.5 million subcontract to undertake civil, structural and mechanical and electrical (M&E) works for a new 275-kilovolt consumer landing station serving a data centre development in the Klang Valley.

The construction group said its wholly-owned subsidiary, Kerjaya Prospek (M) Sdn Bhd (KPM), accepted the letter of award on July 23 from a customer for the execution of the project.

The contract covers the execution, completion, testing where applicable, defect rectification and all incidental obligations relating to the civil, structural and basic low-voltage M&E works for the proposed landing station.

The project will commence immediately on July 23, 2026, and is scheduled for completion by Jan 9, 2027.

Kerjaya Prospek said the contract is expected to contribute positively to the Group's revenue over the next financial year while strengthening its existing order book.

The award is also expected to contribute positively to the earnings and net assets of the Group for the financial years ending Dec 31, 2026, and Dec 31, 2027, without affecting its issued share capital.

The latest contract adds to Kerjaya Prospek's portfolio of data centre-related infrastructure projects, a segment that continues to see robust activity amid rising investments in Malaysia's digital infrastructure and hyperscale data centre developments.

The company said the contract is not expected to have any material impact on its share capital, and none of its directors, major shareholders or persons connected with them have any direct or indirect interest in the award.
