KUALA LUMPUR: Tin and metal producer Malaysia Smelting Corp Metal Bhd (MSC) has been given new long-term mining leases for its tin mine in Perak.

These mining leases, which will run until 2034, are for several parcels of land spanning over 700 hectares in Klian Intan.

The tin mine, operated by wholly owned Rahman Hydraulic Tin Sdn Bhd (RHT), are largest hard-rock open pit tin mine in Malaysia.
The mine has been in operations for 112 years since 1907 and is a significant contributor to the country's tin production.
'With these new leases, we are able to continue our tin mining activities at the existing RHT mine for a further four years until 2034," group CEO Datuk Patrick Yong said in a statement today.
The new mining leases will replace the cancelled previous ones.
The tin mining division contributes 76% of the group's pre-tax profit in Dec 31, 2018.
