

## Data centre projects extend Sunway Construction's earnings streak in 2Q

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KUALA LUMPUR (Aug 21): Sunway Construction Group Bhd (KL:[SUNCON](#) [ASK](#) [EDGE](#)) continued its streak of strong earnings in the second quarter, on the back of continued progress of its data centre projects.

Net profit for the three months ended June 30, 2025 (2QFY2025) stood at RM83.89 million, more than double the RM38.87 million in 2QFY2024, the construction group showed in a bourse filing on Thursday.

Quarterly revenue surged 126.8% year-on-year (y-o-y) to RM1.48 billion from RM651.25 million, driven by accelerated progress of several data centre projects. SunCon underlined that this is the third consecutive quarter the group's revenue exceeded RM1.4 billion.

The group declared a second interim dividend of 7.25 sen per share for the quarter, up from 3.5 sen per share a year ago, payable on Sept 25.

For the first half ended June 30, 2025 (1HFY2025), SunCon's net profit jumped 123.9% y-o-y to RM159.61 million from RM71.27 million in the same period a year ago, as cumulative revenue climbed 129.1% to RM2.88 billion from RM1.26 billion for 1HFY2024.

Looking ahead, SunCon said that while data centres remain a key focus area, it is also broadening its exposure to other high-potential segments.

This includes large-scale civil and infrastructure projects such as the Penang LRT, MRT3, Penang International Airport expansion, and renewable energy projects.

"The group has successfully commissioned and handed over more than 100MW of data centre capacity and is currently managing five ongoing projects for four major multinational clients.

"Backed by a healthy order book, strong financial position, and proven execution capability, the group remains confident of delivering positive results for FY2025, barring any unforeseen circumstances," it added.

SunCon's outstanding orderbook stood at RM6.72 billion, with RM3.81 billion in new orders secured to date — equivalent to 60% of the group's 2025 order replenishment target range of RM4.5 billion to RM6 billion.

Shares in SunCon ended three sen or 0.52% higher at RM5.85 on Thursday, valuing the group at RM7.69 billion.
