SunCon wins RM496mil contracts

Contractor has secured RM1.5bil worth of jobs this year

PETALING JAYA: Sunway Construction Bhd (SunCon) has received three construction contracts totalling RM496mil, pushing its total projects secured this year to RM1.53bil.

In a statement yesterday, the company said the first project, worth RM310mil, was awarded by Petronas Management Training Sdn Bhd for the construction and completion of the Petronas Leadership Centre in Bangi.

SunCon said the job would comprise the construction of a one-storey semi basement car park, four-storey institutional building, two guardhouses, a surau and other associated works and upgrading of ancillary buildings.

Meanwhile, the second project award is from Sunway South Quay for a contract sum of RM119mil for the earthworks, bored pile foundation with secant pile and diaphragm retaining wall works in Sunway South Quay at Sunway City Kuala Lumpur. The third project, worth RM67.8mil, is from Oxley Rising Sdn Bhd and entails the supply, delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of the electrical and mechanical and electrical extra-low voltage system for its proposed mixed commercial development.

The project consists of service suites, hotels and an office block in Jalan Ampang. In the same statement, SunCon managing director Chung Soo Kiong (pic) said he was pleased that the company had met its target

for this year well ahead of schedule.

"We will continue to work to secure new contracts and move forward with our expansion strategy into Asean and India," he said.

In April, SunCon signed a memorandum of understanding with Myanmar's Capital Diamond Star Group, tendering for three rail and road projects in India, as well as pilling works in Singapore.
